30 points - Originality: Avoid the use of trite or worn out words and phrases.

40 points - Development of theme: Stay focused on ideas & thoughts. Don't ramble.

30 points - Mechanics and neatness: Use proper spelling, grammar and punctuation.

All essays need to be at the Lodge by January 21, 2011

We will pick the best three from division I (5th & 6th grades) and division II (7th & 8th grades) on January 23, 2011.
