On May 4th over 800 meals were served to the High Point Pony League during their Annual Family Day event. On May 15th we served over 500 meals at the Veteran's Administration hospital in Salisbury.

You may also be aware our Antlers program (ages 12-20) along with many parents are highly involved in the community and currently sponsor a team at the Miracle Field each weekend. The Miracle Field baseball league is a program designed for local children with disabilities to play baseball, America's pastime, and our Antlers do a fantastic job helping these children while developing their own strong leadership skills. On May 18th we also prepared 80 meals for the closure of the spring Miracle League season. The Antlers have plans to return and volunteer for the fall season as well.

We served lunch to over 300 graduating Southwest High School seniors on May 24th and then our Pool Committee served over 400 free hotdogs to our Members on opening day at the pool.

A big thank you goes out to all of our volunteers. Without you, the Membership, none of these programs would be possible.


