MOST VALUABLE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

For high school seniors who are U.S. citizens

The **Elks National Foundation** will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2015 competition.

- Any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply.
- Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks.
- College students are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be citizens of the United States on the date their applications are signed; permanent legal resident status does not qualify.
- Male and female students compete separately.

It's that time of year again... time for all high school seniors to look into applying for the Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Scholar (MVS) Scholarships!

Scholarships range from \$1,000 - \$60,000 based on academic performance, community service and financial need.

The High Point Elks Lodge had two \$1,000 recipients last year!
