Together we can help prevent these needless tragedies.

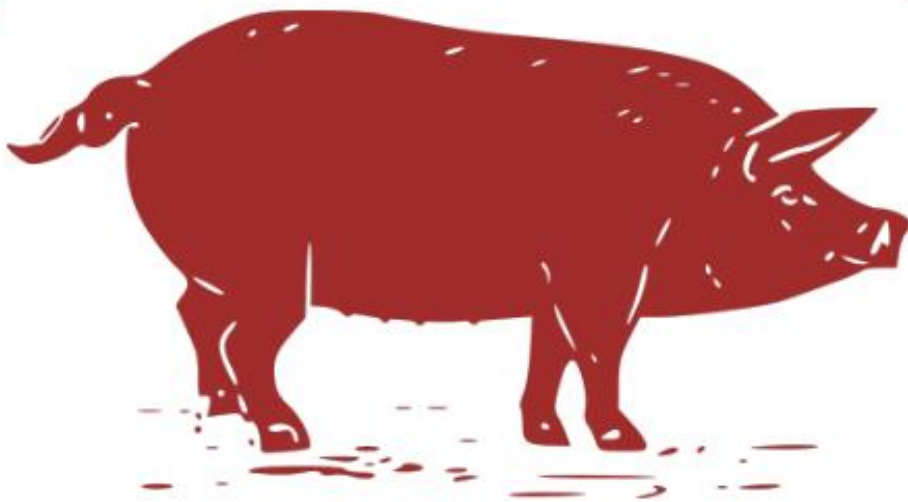
