COVID-19 - HIGH POINT ELKS UPDATE

HIGH POINT LODGE POOL UPDATE

Hello Members of # 1155,

As we near the opening of our pool during these unprecedented times, I wanted post some info about the changes we all need to be aware of due to the Covid-19 Restrictions. Please help us share this info by making sure your pool friends and families see this post. Also, please be familiar with all Pool rules including the ones posted below.

- 1) Under the most recent guidelines, the maximum occupancy for our Pool area is now **250** people, and we do not foresee this being an issue on most days. We will be using the first come/first serve method.
- Only people present at the time of sign-in will be counted towards the maximum occupancy. Anyone else arriving later will need to sign-in separately and could be turned away if we are already at maximum occupancy.
- 3) You MUST bring your own chair(s) to sit in. The white chairs and chaise lounges will not be available and are not to be used until the restrictions are lifted. Any chair(s) brought in by a Pool member must also leave that same day/night.
- 4) A Pool member can only bring in as many chairs as people listed on their Pool card.
- 5) Please read all signage posted throughout the pool area. This is for your safety as well as your fellow members.
- 6) Please practice social distancing while in the pool area.
- 7) Members can pick up their pool card upon their first visit to the pool. <u>Thereafter the card must be present</u> for sign-in purposes each time. We are using information unique to each person's Pool card to help aid the sign-in process, and therefore it must be brought and shown.
- 8) No Alcohol or glass containers of ANY kind can be brought into the pool area.
- 9) ALL coolers and bags (including swim bags, purses, etc.) are subject to search before entering the pool area.
- 10) No Smoking in the pool area or shelter area at any time. Smoking is allowed on the back patio area or outside the pool fence.
- 11) No guests to the pool or new shelter rentals will be allowed until further notice.
- 12) The Lifeguards and Pool Committee are not responsible for monitoring or enforcing Social Distancing. Each member will be responsible for their own and families actions and safety, including the wiping down of tables before/after each use.
- 13) Tables have been spaced out in accordance to Social Distancing rules. Please do not move the tables for any
- 14) Wearing of masks while not in the water is recommended.
- 15) Pool Dues must be paid by noon on May 29th in order to use the pool on opening weekend.

Pool Opens Friday, May 29th at 4pm

Monday, June 1st we are opening with special hours: Mon-Fri 12pm-8pm, Sat & Sun 10am-9pm

Monday, June 15th "summer hours" start: Mon-Fri 11am-9pm, Sat & Sun 10am-9pm

Once GCS is back in session we will revert to "school hours": Mon-Fri 4-8pm, Sat & Sun 10am-9pm

As this is a fluid situation, any of the above is subject to change by the Pool Committee. We appreciate everyone's patience and understanding of some of the new processes we had to put in place in order to open the Pool to our members. There is no blueprint for this, so we are learning as we go along. The Pool Committee has spent a lot of time reviewing these procedures and discussing them and we feel these are the best possible options. Pool Concessions

Hello Fellow Members – we are excited about the upcoming pool season and will be glad to see you. As with most things these days, there are COVID-19 guidelines to observe and that will make for some changes.

- The snack bar will operate and serve as in the past, but please be aware there will be a more limited concessions menu when we open.
- 2) The "Family Room" will open for Vending Machine service only. Once you have made a purchase, please return outside. There will not be available space to remain inside to eat or gather for social activity.
- 3) Physical distancing is required. Everyone should be aware. Please observe proper spacing in the snack bar area at all times. There will be ground marks in line and in the area to help us with this.
- 4) Please clean up after yourselves dispose of any trash.

Snack bar hours:

Friday (5pm-9pm)
Saturday & Sunday (noon-9pm)

Lounge, Bar window and deck

- The bar window will open with COVID-19 requirements and restrictions as well. Physical distancing will need to be observed – the area will be marked for that to provide guidance. Please do not move any tables or chairs on the deck.
- Inside the lounge- we are limited at all times to 50% capacity 56 people.
 Tables and chairs have been placed at the proper distance so please do not move them.
- 3) There will be no sitting or gathering at the bar ... it will be a service area only. Once you receive your drink, please return to your table or outside. If you only need to order beverages, we recommend using the bar window and staying outside.
- 4) Shirt and shoes will be worn at all times when inside the building.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we go through these different times. Please be considerate for the well-being of your family and others. We look forward to seeing our Elk Friends ...

He led every scope of the project from removal, to re-ordering the specific motor and essentials we needed as well as the frame that it sits on, to installation of each and every piece.

Thanks to Tom Day, his knowledge, tools, skills and leadership the motor was back in place around a week later and saved the Lodge a considerable amount of money compared to the cost of having this job outsourced. We are so grateful to have Tom as a member of our Lodge.


