Exalted Rulen Letten



Development of theme: Stay focused on ideas and thoughts. Don't ramble — 40 points

Mechanics and neatness: Use proper spelling, grammar and punctuation — 30 points

Plaques will be awarded by the Grand Lodge for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place for national winning essays in Division I and Division II. Winners will be announced at the Grand Lodge Session in Atlanta, GA, June 3-6, 2022.

Essay should be submitted to local Elks Lodge on/before December 15, 2021

The Essay Contest Cover Sheet must be completed for each level of competition and remain attached to the Essay.


