As I close out my term, I would like to highlight a few of the great accomplishments of the past Elk year, 2021 -2022:

- We grew our membership by 82 new members
- Total Lodge membership is at its highest level in last 10 years with 523 members
- We had member and Guest Events every month of the year
- Pool memberships increased to 1,139, the highest in the last 8 years
- Swim Team had over 125 swimmers, highest in recent years

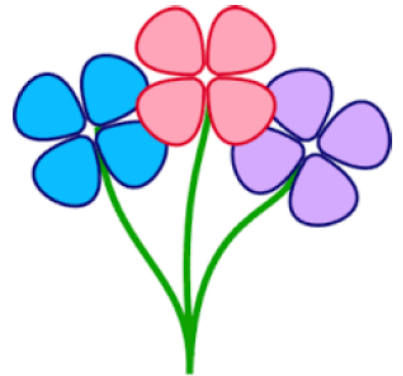
