Our Veterans Committee has been very active this year, here are the recent activities we have been involved in. If you are interested in helping our local veterans, please contact Phil Driscoll, phildriscoll101@gmail.com. We meet the first Thursday of each month at 6:00pm.

- We have provided 13 Welcome Home Kits for Veterans since May through our partnership with the Cassell Transitional House and the High Point Heroes Center.
- We hosted veterans from the Cassell House at our Pool on August 26th. Our volunteers cooked burgers and hot dogs and had a great time.
- Earlier this year we attended the Salute to Women's Veterans event, our Lodge was a \$250 sponsor for the event.
- We gave out ENF Grants to the following Veteran organizations:
 - The Heroes Center \$3,000
 - Tiny Houses of High Point \$1,000
- We will be sponsoring a Veteran for the next Triad Honor Flight in May 2023 with a \$600 Sponsorship.
- We purchased new Armed Service Flags for the Cassell House and will present the flags to them on November 11th.

When transitioning into permanent housing, our 'Welcome Home' kits provide previously homeless Veterans with the essentials needed in a home such as bedding, cleaning supplies, and small electronics like microwaves. We are honored to provide these items on behalf of the BPOE.






