DID YOU SEE?



For the first time since 1995, the Elks had a float in the Tournament of Roses Parade in Pasadena, California, on Jan. 2.

Last year alone, the value of Elks' contributions to the nation's heroes provided more than \$39 million to more than 300 Veterans Administration Medical Centers, clinics, and state care facilities.

The Elks received thousands of scholarship applications in December from high school seniors nationwide, with nearly \$5 million distributed annually. The Elks Community Investment Program will award almost \$16 million towards enriching local communities.

Elks Lodges nationwide donated more than \$368 million last year to the communities they serve throughout the United States and its territories. There are nearly 1,800 Elks Lodges across the country, with a total membership of around 800,000!

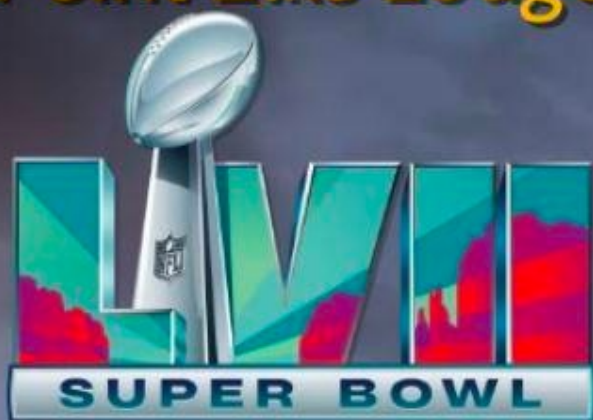
