# LODGE DUES

It's DUES time!

Lodge dues notices have been mailed out along with information for the 2023 pool season.

Please remember that your Lodge dues must be paid before April 1.

Pool dues can be paid at any time.

Members who pay their Lodge dues via the monthly draft will receive their 2023-24 membership cards and pool information in a couple of weeks.

Please remember to keep your blue key card until April 1. <u>Key card locks</u> <u>will be changed on that date</u> and after April 1 you will need the new yellow or red card to enter the building. We operate as a private club under ALE regulations and doors must be kept locked at all times. An option to purchase a key card for your spouse is included on your dues notice, or you can call or come by the office to buy one. Key cards are not for purchase for children and should NEVER be given to a child or guest to enter the building.

Members that have not paid Lodge dues before April 1 are considered delinquent and may not visit the members Lounge or participate in any Lodge activities.

Office hours are 10am-1pm Monday through Friday. If you have any questions or would like to pay Lodge dues over the phone with a credit card, we are happy to help. Pool dues must be mailed with a check or paid in person, and a completed pool card needs to be included. The office is unable to take your pool card information over the phone.
