We are saddened to announce the passing of our brother in Elksdom, David Labiak.

David joined our Lodge in May of 2005. During his time as an Elk, David enthusiastically helped in many important areas in our Lodge, including being a key part of our Membership, Pool, and Swim Team Committees – sometimes being involved in all 3 at the same time.

David's biggest impact to our members and their families was serving as Chairman of our Swim Team Committee for several years. He helped us achieve great success in and out of the water. David's leadership helped grow the number of swimmers we had and guided the Team's success during our regular seasons and at the City Meets.

David was battling MDS (myelodysplastic syndromes) in the last years of his life. Members can honor David by joining the National Marrow Donor Program with a simple cheek swab and donating blood.

VETERANS COMMITTEE UPDATE

Our Lodge's Veterans Committee has been very busy the last several months!

Here is a summary of our latest activities supporting our veterans:

- Grand Opening of Kernersville VA Retirement Home was October 31st. NC State Elks officers and Lodge members from High Point, Greensboro, and Salisbury attended.
- The High Point Realtors Association held a Cornhole Tournament at our Lodge to raise funds for the Cassell Veterans Transitional Home. A total of \$1,445 was raised for them in November along with a Welcome Home Kit.
- Tyler Dixon and Gunny Schman attended the Heroes Center Veterans Holiday event on December 2nd. Gunny was a guest speaker, speaking about what great things the Elks organization does for veterans. Our Lodge donated \$500 in Gift Cards to veterans at the event.
- Several committee members presented a veteran with an American flag purchased by the Lodge for a flagpole at his house. The flagpole was installed by Tyler Dixon.
- Rich Golden attended the September Heroes Center monthly "Coffee with Veterans" and Phil Driscoll and Tyler Dixon attended the November event.
- We once again provided Christmas Dinner for the Cassell Veterans Transitional Home.
- The Ladies Auxiliary Giving Tree this year was for two veteran families in need.
- The Committee recommended a \$1,000 donation to go to building a waterfall feature at the Cassell House. Tyler Dixon is donating the work to install it. This recommendation was approved at the Lodge meeting on December 13th.
- Our Lodge donated \$500 and the Ladies Auxiliary bought Christmas gifts for a Marine veteran and his family who lost everything in a house fire the week before Christmas.
- So far this year, our Veterans Committee has donated "Welcome Home Kits" to 5 homeless veterans that are transitioning to a new home. The kits include bedding, kitchen and bath items, cleaning supplies, and small appliances.

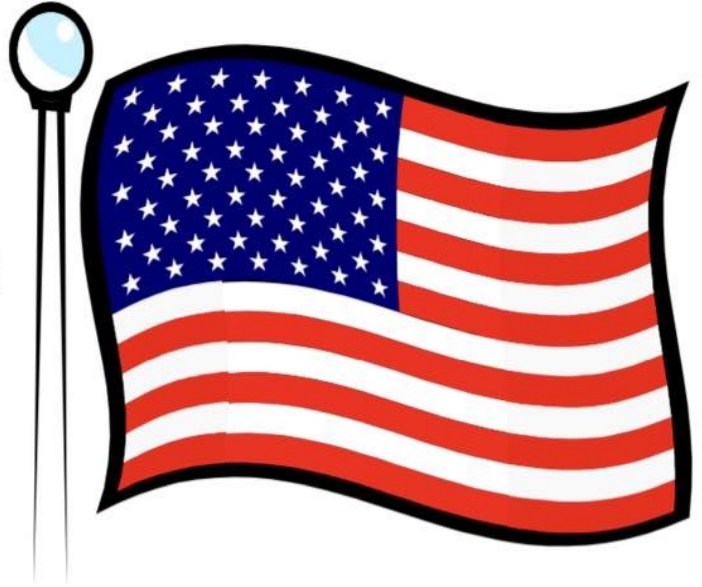
