As opening day of the Pool is just around the corner, here are some Pool Membership and Office hours reminders:

- Office Hours are Monday-Friday from 10am until 1pm. The Office is closed on weekends.
- On opening day of Pool season (Friday, May 24th) the Office is not accepting any payments after 1pm sharp so they have time to get all the pool membership paperwork and cards ready.
- Lodge dues must be paid before a pool membership card can be issued.
- The Pool Application must be filled out and presented with payment (these were mailed out a few weeks ago, but we have extra copies in the Elks upstairs lobby if needed)
- Payments can be made with cash, check or credit card. (Note: Payments cannot be taken over the phone)
- Payments can be made during office hours, at the bar in the Lounge or can be slipped under the upstairs office door if need be.

The Pool opens at 5pm on Friday, May 24th. Upon your first visit, the Guard room will have your Pool card(s) ready to be picked up upon check-in. After your initial visit, and for the safety and security of our Members we will once again be asking for 2 forms of ID at each visit to the pool.

Any combination of your Pool card, Elks Membership card, Driver's license, Military ID, etc. will be accepted.

Having your Elks Pool card as one of the forms of ID will gain you quickest entry, as not having your pool card will mean your name will need to be double checked against a list to ensure we are only allowing Pool members and their guests access.


