The Fourth of July celebration is right around the corner, take advantage of all the wonderful activities your Lodge has to offer and celebrate your independence in our great nation.



Our Lodge has formed a partnership with the non-profit organization GO FAR, which stands for 'Go Out For A Run,' to sponsor their Lace Up program. We successfully applied for and received the Elks National Foundation (ENF) Gratitude Grant, allowing us to present GO FAR with a \$2,500 check. The Lace Up program provides new sneakers to elementary school children at Title 1 schools in High Point.

In addition, GO FAR offers an 8 to 10-week comprehensive fitness program aimed at educating children of all abilities on healthy eating, goal setting, and training for a 5K walk/run. Our Lodge is further supporting their efforts with an ENF Grant for the Holistic Learning Labs, facilitated by Kitchenology. Further information about these Labs will be available in next month's newsletter. Following the fitness programs, GO FAR hosts a community-wide 5K walk/run event twice a year, in the Spring and Fall.



We will need Lodge members to assist with both the Lace Up program and the 5K events. Tasks include measuring children's shoe sizes and distributing the shoes. Additionally, **volunteers are needed** for race day activities. These events offer a wonderful opportunity for our members to demonstrate the Elks' commitment to our community. Stay tuned for more details on these volunteering opportunities.

Much planning is happening regarding a November Vendor Sale and also a January 'Red, White, and Blue Ball' to celebrate the High Point Elks 115th Anniversary.




